

- 1. Place bottom section (B) of fixture body on floor.
- 2. Lower top section (A) of fixture body down towards bottom section (B) of fixture body. Fit threaded ends of legs on top section (A) of fixture body into openings in legs on bottom section (B) of fixture body.
- 3. Thread one screw into hole in each leg on bottom section (B) of fixture body. Tighten screws to secure top section (A) to bottom section (B) of fixture body.
- 4. Insert recommended bulb (not included) into socket (A). **WARNING:** Verify correct bulb wattage marked on socket of lamp. DO NOT exceed maximum bulb wattage.
